AMP Capital Investors Managing Director Stephen Dunne said the appointment is the next step in fulfilling AMP Capital's offshore growth ambitions and further builds its international investment management capabilities.

"To achieve our growth objectives we need to further expand outside our traditional Australasian markets to grow our business and provide clients with access to high value-add investment opportunities.
