He most recently spent three years with RARE Infrastructure as a Senior Equity Analyst, solely focused on infrastructure stocks. Mr Humphreys will be responsible for coverage of European companies and will work from both AMP Capital's London and Sydney offices.

Jonathan Reyes has eight years of financial experience in roles with Bear Sterns & Co. in New York and RARE Infrastructure in Sydney. Most recently, he was an investment analyst with RARE Infrastructure where he covered Australia and emerging markets infrastructure securities. Based in Sydney, Mr Reyes will support the team in researching Asia Pacific and emerging markets securities.

AMP Capital Investors Managing Director Stephen Dunne said: "AMP Capital is a global leader in infrastructure investing and we continue to build on our world class infrastructure capability covering listed, direct and infrastructure debt.
